In consideration of the Cole Land Transportation Museum providing Kindle Fires for school use, we agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. We agree to coordinate and send to the Cole Land Transportation Museum a minimum of one busload of students (50 or more) to participate in a two and one half hour field trip consisting of a tour and either the Veteran Interview for grades 6-12 or the Junior Curator program for younger grades within 12 months of receiving the Kindle Fires. Schools may elect to pay it forward by sending their Middle school or High School students. The Cole Land Transportation Museum is open from May 1st to November 11th. Failure to meet this condition nullifies this agreement and the Kindle Fires will be returned to the Galen Cole Family Foundation.
2. Schools receiving Kindle Fires will be solely responsible for communicating with Amazon for the content and capability of the units.
3. We agree to utilize the Kindle Fires for educational purposes within the school and return them in "good" condition if this agreement is terminated for any reason.
4. We agree to maintain the Kindle Fires in good working order during the term of this agreement.
5. We understand that the Kindle Fires will become the property of the school when item one above is successfully completed.
6. We agree to insure the Kindle Fires for full value against breakage, loss or theft and release the GCFF and its officers and employees from actual or potential claims of liability associated with said Kindle Fires.
