Sumner Memorial High School and the Pathways program are requesting approval from the RSU #24 Board to pursue this grant for the purpose of creating a model for the SMHS Pathways' Alternative Education Model that is sustainable, while supporting the local community work force and the student population. Funds from this grant will be used locally and reinvested into the local community. 1.. Transportation to sites for career exploration (\$500.00):

2. Service clothing (\$500.00):

Scrubs, Welding Masks, Steel Boots, Gloves, and other associated career clothing and equipment for internships and job experiences.

3. Safe-Serv for student training (\$1000.00):

This certification will allow students to engage in seasonal work or culinary positions throughout the community.

4. Specialized instruction for trades and skills (both within the building and out in the community - \$2,500.00):

Possibly through local Adult Ed. programs or Adult Ed Instructors - featuring areas in Health, Biology Research, Archeology, Welding, & Financial Literacy.

5. Career Internship Training (\$4,800.00):

15-week program. Cost estimate of \$800.00 per student (6 students) including transportation, minimal compensation, lunch.
