SMHS Co-Curricular Eligibility

In order to determine student eligibility for participation in Co-Curricular Activities (CCA) eligibility reviews will be conducted every two weeks by the Assistant Principal & Athletic Director to assess any record(s) of student violations of RSU 24 policies <u>JIC</u> and <u>JIC-R</u>. Policy violations will be recorded in Infinite Campus, the district Student Information System.

- 1. Policy violations are recorded by school staff and administration when student behavior violates RSU 24 policies JIC and JIC-R.
- 2. Students deemed ineligible to participate in a CCA will be required to attend but not participate in practices/rehearsals/competitions during the ineligibility period.
- 3. Any student violations of RSU 24 policies JIC and JIC-R will be investigated in a timely manner to determine eligibility for participation in practices/rehearsals/competitions/events for the day that the violation(s) occurs.
- 4. Violations of policies JIC and JIC-R will be associated with a points-value system:
 - a. Level 1 JIC-R violations are equal to 1 point
 - b. Level 2 JIC-R violations are equal to 2 points
 - c. Level 3 JIC-R violations are equal to 3 points

If a student reaches the threshold of <u>4 points associated with violations</u> within the two-week eligibility review will be deemed ineligible from participating in their CCA for a calendar week (7 days).

- 5. Any student that surpasses 5 or more points associated with violations within the two-week eligibility review will be deemed ineligible within their CCA for a duration of 2 calendar weeks (14 days).
- 6. Eligibility determinations within a CCA as the result of policy infractions will be decided upon by the Assistant Principal and the Athletic Director through the application of policies JIC and JIC-R action steps. Final determinations will be made with the approval of the Principal and/or Superintendent by taking into account the nature and severity of the policy JIC-R infraction(s).
